I. God Reveals Truths About Himself to All People. (Romans 1: 18-21)

**He reveals two truths about His invisible
attributes or characteristics:**

A. His Eternal Power. (Romans 1:20)

B. His Divine Nature. (Romans 1:20)

II. All People Turn Away from God Because of Sin and Need Redemption. (Romans 1:21-23)

People take the knowledge of God's revelation and respond with:

- A. Arrogance- a sense of acting self-sufficient without God. (Romans 1: 21-22)**
- B. Rebellion- an improper attitude toward God. (Romans 1: 22 and 28-31)**
- C. Idolatry - men worship false gods. (Romans 1: 23)**

III. All Persons Without Christ Spend Eternity in Hell Separated from God.

A. Hell is a place of agony. (Matthew 13: 42)

B. Hell is a place of torment. (Luke 16:23)

C. Hell is a place of eternal punishment.

D. Hell is a place of eternal separation from God.

(2 Thessalonians 1: 9; John 3:36)

IV. Believers Are Privileged to Share the Gospel with Everyone. (Romans 1: 14--17)

- A. I am under obligation to others.
(Romans 1:14)**
- B. I am eager to share the gospel.
(Romans 1: 15)**
- C. I am not ashamed of the gospel.
(Romans 1:16)**
- D. The gospel is the power of God that brings salvation to all who believe.
(Romans 1: 16-17)**
